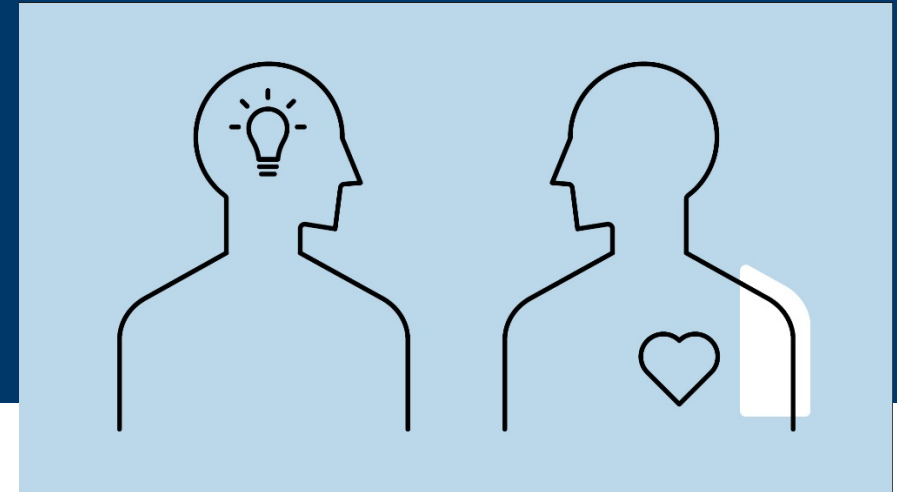


# Knowledge and values – significance for science and society
